## Crochet Patchwork Bag (Intermediate)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) $48 \mathrm{cms} / 19 \mathrm{ins}$ Length (approx, excluding handles) $32 \mathrm{cms} / 12.6$ ins

## SEAN SHEEP YARN ROKEWOOD

$2 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ Main Colour (MC - Purple)
$1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ Contrast Colour 1 (C1 - Dusty Pink)
$1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ Contrast Colour 2 (C2-Orange)
$1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ Contrast Colour 3 (C3-Blue)
$1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ Contrast Colour 4 (C4-Jade Blue)

## HOOKS

A 4.50mm (US 7), (UK 7) Crochet Hook.
Note - Correct tension/gauge is not essential for these items.

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle, a pair of ready made handles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Note - Instructions are given in UK/ Australian terminology.
St/s - stitch/es, ch - chain, dc - double crochet (US single crochet), sl st - slip stitch, tr - treble (US double crochet), rep - repeat.

## CREATE GRANNY SQUARES x 17

Make 4 ch, join with a sl st into 1 st ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Using C1-3 ch, work in ring - 2 tr, 3 ch, *3 tr, 3 ch. Repeat from * twice more. Sl st into top of 3 ch , sl st into top of next 2 tr , and sl st into 1 ch space.

CHANGE COLOUR
Round 2: Using C2-3 ch, $2 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ into below 3 ch loop, 1 ch, * ( $3 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into 3 ch space, 1 ch. Repeat from * twice more. SI st into top of 3 ch , sl st into top of next 2 tr , and sl st into 3 ch space.

## CHANGE COLOUR

Round 3: Using C3-3 ch, $2 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$, into 3 ch loop, * $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ into 1 ch space, 1 ch , ( 3 tr , $3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into 3 ch corner space. Repeat from * twice more, $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ tr into 1 ch space, 1 ch . SI st into top of 3 ch , sl st into top of next 2 tr , and sl st into 3 ch space.

## CHANGE COLOUR

Round 4: Using MC - 3 ch, 2 tr, 3 ch, 3 tr into below 3 ch loop, * 1 ch, 3 tr into next 1 ch space, $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ tr into next 1 ch space, 1 ch , ( $3 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, 3 tr ) into next 3 ch corner space. Repeat from * twice more, $1 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ tr into next 1 ch space, 1 ch , 3 tr into 1 ch space, 1 ch . Sl st into top of 3 ch .

Tie off yarn and thread back all threads.
Work another 16 squares as above, changing colours to suit for rounds 1 to 3, but keeping the colour for round 4 the same each time (MC).

## FINISHING

Using yarn needle, darn in ends.
Lay squares out as shown on diagram. Stitch together edges of granny squares using whip stitch. Attach handles to top corners of bag.
