# SEAN SHEEP Crochet Patchwork Bag

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Yarns required to make Bag: 6 x 100g balls



# Crochet Patchwork Bag (Intermediate)

# MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) 48 cms/19 ins Length (approx, excluding handles) 32 cms/12.6 ins

# SEAN SHEEP YARN ROKEWOOD

2 x 100g Main Colour (MC - Purple) 1 x 100g Contrast Colour 1 (C1 - Dusty Pink) 1 x 100g Contrast Colour 2 (C2 - Orange) 1 x 100g Contrast Colour 3 (C3 - Blue) 1 x 100g Contrast Colour 4 (C4 - Jade Blue)

# HOOKS

A 4.50mm (US 7), (UK 7) Crochet Hook. Note - Correct tension/gauge is not essential for these items.

### MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle, a pair of ready made handles.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

# Note - Instructions are given in UK/ Australian terminology.

**St/s** - stitch/es, **ch** - chain, **dc** - double crochet (US single crochet), **sl st** - slip stitch, **tr** - treble (US double crochet), **rep** - repeat.

# CREATE GRANNY SQUARES x 17

Make 4 ch, join with a sl st into 1st ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Using C1 – 3 ch, work in ring – 2 tr, 3 ch, \*3 tr, 3 ch. Repeat from \* twice more. SI st into top of 3 ch, sI st into top of next 2 tr, and sI st into 1 ch space.

#### CHANGE COLOUR

Round 2: Using C2 - 3 ch, 2 tr, 3 ch, 3 tr into below 3 ch loop, 1 ch, \* (3 tr, 1ch, 3 tr) into 3 ch space, 1 ch. Repeat from \* twice more. SI st into top of 3 ch, sI st into top of next 2 tr, and sI st into 3 ch space.

### CHANGE COLOUR

Round 3: Using C3 - 3 ch, 2 tr, 3 ch, 3 tr, into 3 ch loop, \* 1 ch, 3 tr into 1 ch space, 1 ch, (3 tr, 3 ch, 3 tr) into 3 ch corner space. Repeat from \* twice more, 1 ch, 3 tr into 1 ch space, 1 ch. SI st into top of 3 ch, sI st into top of next 2 tr, and sI st into 3 ch space.

#### CHANGE COLOUR

Round 4: Using MC - 3 ch, 2 tr, 3 ch, 3 tr into below 3 ch loop, \* 1 ch, 3 tr into next 1 ch space, 1 ch, 3 tr into next 1 ch space, 1 ch, (3 tr, 3 ch, 3 tr) into next 3 ch corner space. Repeat from \* twice more, 1 ch, 3 tr into next 1 ch space, 1 ch, 3 tr into 1 ch space, 1 ch. SI st into top of 3 ch.


Tie off yarn and thread back all threads.

Work another 16 squares as above, changing colours to suit for rounds 1 to 3, but keeping the colour for round 4 the same each time (MC).

#### FINISHING

Using yarn needle, darn in ends.

Lay squares out as shown on diagram. Stitch together edges of granny squares using whip stitch. Attach handles to top corners of bag.



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
