Yarns required to make Shrug:
5 x 100g balls



Circular Shrug (Beginner)

MEASUREMENTS

One size fits most

Outer circumference (approx)

135 cms/53 ins

Length (approx, when worn)

50 cms/20 ins

SEAN SHEEP ROKWOOD YARN

5 x 100g balls

NEEDLES

2 x 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Circular Needles (60 cms/23½ & 80 cms/31 ins long) **or size that gives correct tension/gauge.**

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

TENSION/GAUGE

13 sts and 19 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over stocking st, using 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

St/s - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **stocking st** - 1 row K, 1 row P, **rep** - rep, **beg** - begin/ning, **M1** - make one st, by picking up loop that lies before next st, place on left hand needle and knit or purl into back of loop.

CREATE

Right Back & Front/Left Back & Front
(make 2 pieces alike)

Using 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Circular Needle, cast on 60 sts.

1st round - * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st round until work measures 3.5 cms/1½ ins from beg.

Next round - * K1, M1 knitways, P1, rep from * to end = 90 sts.

Next round - * K2, P1, rep from * to end. Rep last round until work measures 9 cms/3½ ins from beg.

Next round - * K1, M1 purlways, K1, P1, rep from * to end = 120 sts.

Next round - * K2, P2, rep from * to end. Rep last round until work measures 14 cms/5½ ins from beg.

Next round - * K1, M1 knitways, K1, P2, rep from * to end = 150 sts.

Next round - * K3, P2, rep from * to end. Rep last round until work measures 19 cms/7 ins from beg.

Next round - * K3, P1, M1 purlways, P1, rep from * to end = 180 sts.

Next round - * K3, P3, rep from * to end. Rep last round until work measures 24 cms/9 ins from beg.

Next round - * P3, K3, rep from * to end. Rep last round until work measures 30 cms/12 ins from beg.

Cast/bind off loosely in rib.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in all ends. Using yarn needle and a flat seam, join cast/bound off edges of the two pieces together for approx 20 cms/8 ins at centre back seam.
