Hexagon Crochet Throw

(Intermediate)

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) 92 cms/36½ ins

Height (approx) 130 cms/51 ins

SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD YARN

8 x 50g balls 1st Colour (C1)

8 x 50g balls 2nd Colour (C2)

8 x 50g balls 3rd Colour (C3)

HOOKS

A 6.50mm (US K/10½), (UK 3) Crochet Hook **or size that gives correct tension/gauge.**

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

TENSION/GAUGE

One Hexagon measures approx 13 cms/5 ins in diameter, using 6.50mm (US K/10½), (UK 3) Crochet Hook.

Note – Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful item.

ABBREVIATIONS

Note – Instructions are given in UK/ Australian terminology.

beg - begin/ning, **ch** - chain, **sl st** - slip stitch, **tr** - treble, **yoh** - yarn over hook, **rep** - repeat.

Cluster 2 - leaving the last loop on the hook, make 2tr, yoh and draw through 3 loops.

Cluster 3 - leaving the last loop on the hook, make 3tr, yoh and draw through 4 loops.

BASIC HEXAGON

Using 6.50mm (US K/10½), (UK 3) Hook, make 4ch and join with a sl st to form a ring.

1st Round - 3ch, Cluster 2, 2ch, * Cluster 3, 2ch, rep from * 4 times, sl st in 3rd ch at beg. Change colour.

2nd Round - sl st into 2ch sp, 3ch, (Cluster 2, 2ch, Cluster 3) into same 2ch sp, * 2ch, (Cluster 3, 2ch, Cluster 3) into next 2ch sp, rep from * end, 2ch, sl st into 3rd ch at beg. Change colour.

3rd Round - sl st into 2ch sp, 3ch, 2tr into same 2ch sp, * (3tr, 1ch, 3tr) into next 2ch sp, 3tr into next 2ch sp, rep from * to last 2ch sp, (3tr, 1ch, 3tr) into last 2ch sp, sl st into 3rd ch at beg.

Fasten off.

CREATE

Make a total of 77 Hexagons in colour combinations of choice.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Lay out the hexagons in 7 rows of 11 of colour placement of choice, then join Hexagons using a flat seam.
