

SEAN SHEEP

Cable Throw

Yarn required: **SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD Three Colour Throw** 8 x 50g balls 1st Colour (**C1**) 8 x 50g balls 2nd Colour (**C2**) 8 x 50g balls 3rd Colour (**C3**) **Single Colour Throw** 24 x 50g balls

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Cable Throw

(Intermediate)

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) 100 cms/40 ins Length (approx, excluding tassels) 100 cms/40 ins

SEAN SHEEP YARN ROKEWOOD Three Colour Throw

4 x 100g balls 1st Colour (C1) 4 x 100g balls 2nd Colour (C2) 4x 100g balls 3rd Colour (C3) Single Colour Throw 12 x 100g balls

NEEDLES

A pair 10.00mm (US 15), (UK 000) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/ gauge.

MATERIALS

A Cable Needle; A Yarn Needle.

TENSION/GAUGE

8.5 sts and 12 rows to 10 cm/4 ins over stocking st, using 10.00mm (US 15), (UK 000) Knitting Needles and 2 strands of yarn together.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

St/s - stitch/es, K - Knit, P - purl, garter st every row knit, stocking st - 1 row K, 1 row P, RS - right side, WS - wrong side, inc increase, beg - begin/ning, patt - pattern, rep - repeat, cont - continue, P2tog - purl 2 sts together.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

C12B - slip next 6 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K6, then K6 from cable needle.

CREATE

Three Colour Throw (worked in panels) Panel A (make 2) Using 10.00mm (US 15), (UK 000) Needles and 2 strands of C1 together, cast on 16 sts. Knit 2 rows garter st (1st row is WS). 3rd row - K4, P2, inc purlways once in each of next 4 sts, P2, K4 = 20 sts. Beg patt - 1st row (RS) - K2, P2, K12, P2, K2. 2nd row - K4, P12, K4. Rep 1st and 2nd rows 3 times. 9th row - K2, P2, C12B, P2, K2. 10th row - As 2nd row. Rep 1st and 2nd rows 4 times. Last 18 rows form patt. Cont in patt until work measures approx 98 cms/39 ins from beg, ending with a 15th patt row. Next row (WS) - K4, P2, (P2tog) 4 times, P2, K4 = 16 sts. Knit 2 rows garter st. Cast/bind off loosely knitways.

Panel B (make 2) Work as for Panel A, using 2 strands of C3 together in place of C1.

Panel C (make 1) Work as for Panel A, using 2 strands of C2 together in place of C1.

Single Colour Throw

Work to correspond with **Three Colour Throw**, working in one colour only, noting to have 2 strands of yarn together throughout.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends.

Using yarn needle and a flat seam, sew panels together in following order - Panel A, B, C, A and B.

Make 4 tassels using **C1, C2 and C3**, each tassel being 20 cms/8 ins long when finished. = 12 tassels in total.

Attach tassels evenly along cast on and cast/bound off edges of throw as pictured.
