



# Cable Blanket with Tassels (Intermediate)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Size (approx) 95 x 120 cms/37 x 47 ins

## **SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD YARN**

24 x 50g balls

#### **NEEDLES**

A pair 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

#### **MATERIALS**

A Cable Needle; A Yarn Needle.

#### TENSION/GAUGE

13 sts and 19 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over stocking st, using 6.50mm (US  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ), (UK 3) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**St/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **stocking st** - 1 row K, 1 row P, **beg** - begin/ning, **patt** - pattern, **rep** - repeat, **cont** - continue.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**C10F** - slip next 5 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K5, then K5 from cable needle.

**C10B** - slip next 5 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K5, then K5 from cable needle.

#### **CREATE**

Panels (make 6)

Using 6.50mm (US  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ), (UK 3) Needles, cast on 36 sts.

Knit 1 row (WS).

Beg patt - 1st row (RS) - K3, P5, K20, P5, K3.

2nd row - P3, K5, P20, K5, P3.

3rd row - K3, P5, K10, C10F, P5, K3.

4th row - As 2nd row.

5th row - K3, P5, C10B, K10, P5, K3.

6th row - As 2nd row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice.

Last 10 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 120 cms/47 ins from beg, ending with a 7th patt

Next row (WS) - Knit.

Cast/bind off loosely knitways.

## **FINISHING**

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends.

Using yarn needle and mattress st seam, join panels together. Using remaining yarn, make 4 chunky tassels and attach to each corner of blanket.
