## Crachet Jpinning Theel Jhrauk

Yarn required:

## SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD

$8 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ balls 1 st Colour (C1)
$8 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ balls 2 nd Colour (C2)
$8 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ balls 3rd Colour (C3)
$8 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ balls 4 th Colour (C4)

# Crochet Spinning Wheel Throw <br> (Intermediate) 

## MEASUREMENTS

Size (approx) $160 \mathrm{cms} \times 120 \mathrm{cms} / 63 \mathrm{ins} \times 47 \mathrm{ins}$

## SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD YARN

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$8 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ balls 4 th Colour (C4)

## HOOKS

A 6.50 mm (US K/10½), (UK 3) Crochet Hook or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

## TENSION/GAUGE

1 large square measures approx $15 \mathrm{cms} / 6$ ins in width, using 6.50 mm (US K/10½), (UK 3) Crochet Hook.
Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful item.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Note - Instructions are given for UK/Australian terminology.
ch - chain, dtr - double treble, beg - begin/ ning, tr - treble, sl st - slip stitch.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

3tr tog - wrap yarn around hook, insert hook into next stitch, wrap the yarn, draw a loop through, wrap the yarn and draw through 2 of the loops on the hook, repeat twice more, into same space (4 loops on hook), wrap the yarn and draw through all the loops on the hook to complete.

## CREATE

Large Square (make 32)
Note - When making squares, alternate colours for each round and alternate colours between squares as pictured.
Using 6.50mm (US K/10½), (UK 3) Hook, make 6ch, join with sl st.

1st round - 4ch (counts as 1dtr), 19dtr into ring, join with sl st to top beg 4ch.
2nd round - 3ch (counts as 1tr), (2tr, 1ch) into next space 19 times, 1 tr into next space, sl st into top of beg 3ch.
3rd round - SI st into first space, 3ch, (counts as 1 tr ), 2 tr tog, 1 ch , (3tr tog, 1 ch ) into next 1 ch space 19 times, sl st into top of beg 3ch.
4th round - 3ch (counts as 1tr), * 3tr into next 2ch space, 4 times, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into next 2ch sp, repeat from * twice, 3tr, 1 ch, 2tr into last 2ch sp, sl st into top of beg 3ch.
Fasten off.

## Small Square (make 96)

Note - When making squares, alternate colours for each round and alternate colours between squares as pictured.
Using 6.50 mm (US K/10½), (UK 3) Hook, make 4ch, join with sl st.
1 st round - 3ch (counts as 1tr), 2tr, 2ch; (3tr, 2ch) 3 times into ring, sl st to top of beg 3ch.
2nd round - 3ch (counts as 1tr); 6tr into each $2 \mathrm{ch}, 5 \mathrm{tr}$ into next ch space, sl st to top of beg 3ch.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends.
Sew 3 small squares together in a row, then sew the side edge of these 3 small squares to the side edge of a large square to make a rectangle. Continue to form these rectangles noting to alternate the side edge that the 3 small squares are sewn. Sew the rectangles together alternating the edges of the 3 small squares as pictured.
