



SEAN SHEEP 

Pom Pom Feet

Yarn required:

SEAN SHEEP POM POM YARN

Years 3 (5-6)

Short Boots 1 x 250g ball

Long Boots 1 x 250g ball



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Skill Level **Intermediate**

Pom Pom Feet *(Intermediate)*

MEASUREMENTS

Years 3 (5-6)

To fit foot (approx) 15 (17-19) cms/6 (7-7½) ins

Short height (approx) 10 (11-12) cms/4 (4½-5) ins

Long height (approx) 20 (21-22) cms/8 (8½-9) ins

SEAN SHEEP POM POM YARN

Short Boots 1 x 250g ball

Long Boots 1 x 250g ball

NEEDLES

A pair 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Knitting Needles **or size that gives correct tension/gauge.**

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle; Matching plain yarn for sewing seams.

TENSION/GAUGE

6 sts and 15 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over garter st, using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt - alternate, **beg** - begin/ning, **cont** - continue, **dec** - decrease, **foll** - follow/ing, **garter st** - every row knit, **inc** - increase, **K** - knit, **K2tog** - knit 2 sts together, **rep** - repeat, **st/s** - stitch/es.

SPECIAL NOTES

1. When knitting make sure that on each stitch a pom pom is left at the back of the work, ie. Work each stitch between each pom pom on the yarn.
2. Work the thumb method when casting on sts rather than using a pair of needles, ensure that each stitch has a pom pom.
3. When casting off, knit into front of st, then slip the remainder of the st from left hand needle onto right hand needle, thus creating 2 sts. Repeat this for all sts across row, thus doubling the amount of sts, then cast off sts loosely in usual manner.

CREATE

Top (make 2)

Using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles and thumb method (refer to Note 2), cast on 24 (26-28) sts.

Knit 4 rows (refer to Note 1).

Dec one st each end of next row and foll alt row = 20 (22-24) sts.

Next row - Knit to last 4 sts, * knit into front of next st, then slip the remainder of the st from left hand needle onto right hand needle (refer Note 3), rep from * to end.

Next row - Cast/bind off 8 sts, knit to last 4 sts, * knit into front of st, then slip the remainder of the st from left hand needle onto right hand needle, rep from * to end.

Next row - Cast/bind off 8 sts, knit to end = 12 (14-16) sts.

Cont until work measures approx for Short Boots 4 (5-6) cms/1½ (2-2) ins or for Long Boots 14 (15-16) cms/5½ (6-6) ins from beg of cast/bind off.

Cast/bind off (refer to Note 3).

Sole (make 2)

Using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles and Thumb Method, cast on 4 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Inc one st each end of next row = 6 sts.

Cont until work measures approx 14 (16-18) cms/5½ (6-7) ins from beg.

Dec one st each end of next and foll alt row = 2 sts.

Next row - K2, **turn**. K2tog. Fasten off.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Using matching plain yarn, secure ends of pom poms. With right sides together, join centre front seam. With wrong sides together and matching centre front and centre back, sew soles in place.
