5 x 100g balls (C2)

**Large** - 21 x 100g balls

# Chunky Soft Pouffes

## MEASUREMENTS

### Small

Diameter (approx) 30 cms/12 ins

Height (approx) 20 cms/8 ins

### Large

Diameter (approx) 60 cms/24 ins

Height (approx) 30 cms/12 ins

## SEAN SHEEP CHUNKY TEXAS YARN

### Small

5 x 100g balls 1st Colour (**C1**)

5 x 100g balls 2nd Colour (**C2**)

### Large

21 x 100g balls

## NEEDLES

A pair 12mm (US 17), (UK -) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle; 2 x large bags of Polyfill.

## TENSION/GAUGE

**6 sts in width to 10 cms/4 ins over garter st, using 12.00mm (US 17), (UK -) Knitting Needles.**

**Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**St/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **garter st** - every row knit, **patt** - pattern, **cont** - continue, **rep** - repeat, **beg** - begin/ning.

## CREATE

### Small Pouf

Using 12.00mm (US 17), (UK -) Needles and using **C1** cast on 12 sts, then using **C2** cast on 11 sts = 23 sts in total.

#### First Section -

**Beg patt - 1st row** - Using **C2**, K11; using **C1**, (K1, P1) 6 times.

**2nd row** - Using **C1**, (P1, K1) 6 times; using **C2**, K11.

Last 2 rows form patt throughout.

**Beg turnings** - When turning, bring yarn to front of work, slip next st onto right hand needle, yarn back, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed, this avoids holes in work.

Keeping patt and colours correct throughout cont as follows - **3rd and 4th rows** - Patt to last 2 sts, **turn**.

**5th and 6th rows** - Patt to last 3 sts, **turn**.

**7th and 8th rows** - Patt to last 4 sts, **turn**.

Cont turning in this manner working 1 extra st at end of rows before turning until the 2 rows of "Patt to last 6 sts, turn" has been worked.

**Next row** - Patt to end.

#### Second Section -

**\*\* 2nd row** - Patt across all sts to end.

**3rd and 4th rows** - Patt to last 2 sts, **turn**.

**5th and 6th rows** - Patt to last 3 sts, **turn**.

**7th and 8th rows** - Patt to last 4 sts, **turn**.

Cont turning in this manner working 1 extra st at end of rows until the 2 rows of "Patt to last 6 sts, turn" has been worked.

**Next row** - Patt to end. **\*\***

Rep from **\*\*** to **\*\*** until work measures approx 95 cms/37ins through **centre** of work, noting to work a complete section. Cast/bind off knitways.

### Large Pouf

Using 12mm (US 17), (UK -) Needles, cast on 45 sts.

#### First Section -

**Beg patt - 1st row** - K23, (K1, P1) 11 times.

**2nd row** - (P1, K1) 11 times, K23.

Last 2 rows form patt throughout.

**Beg turnings** - When turning, bring yarn to front of work, slip next st onto right hand needle, yarn back, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed, this avoids holes in work.

**3rd and 4th rows** - Patt to last 2 sts, **turn**.

**5th and 6th rows** - Patt to last 3 sts, **turn**.

**7th and 8th rows** - Patt to last 4 sts, **turn**.

Cont turning in this manner working 1 extra st at end of rows before turning until the 2 rows of "Patt to last 15 sts, turn" has been worked.

**Next row** - Patt to end.

#### Second Section -

**\*\* 2nd row** - Patt across all sts to end.

**3rd and 4th rows** - Patt to last 2 sts, **turn**.

**5th and 6th rows** - Patt to last 3 sts, **turn**.

**7th and 8th rows** - Patt to last 4 sts, **turn**.

Cont turning in this manner working 1 extra st at end of rows until the 2 rows of "Patt to last 15 sts, turn" has been worked.

**Next row** - Patt to end. **\*\***

Rep from **\*\*** to **\*\*** until work measures approx 189 cms/74 ins through **centre** of work, noting to work a complete section. Cast/bind off knitways.

## FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Work a running thread along one side edge. Draw up tightly and fasten off securely. Rep along other side edge. Join cast on and cast/bound off edges together, leaving an opening for filling. Fill and close opening.
