
SEAN SHEEP



Comfy Rib Necklet

(Easy Knitting)

MEASUREMENTS

Depth (approx) 20 cms/10 ins **Circumference** (approx) 140 cms/55 ins

SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD YARN

3 x 100g balls

NEEDLES

A 7.00mm (US 10½), (UK 2) Circular Needle or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

TENSION/GAUGE

12 sts in width to 10 cms/4 ins over stocking st, using 7.00mm (US $10\frac{1}{2}$), (UK 2) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

St/s - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **stocking st** - 1 row K, 1 row P, **rep** - repeat, **beg** - begin/ning.

CREATE

Necklet

Using 7.00mm (US 10½), (UK 2) Circular Needle, cast on 182 sts.

1st round - * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st round until work measures 20 cms/8 ins from beg.

Cast/bind off in loosely in rib.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends.
