Yarn required:

SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD

4 x 100g balls (C1)

4 x 100g balls (C2)

4 x 100g balls (C3)

Chevron Throw

(Intermediate Knitting)

MEASUREMENTS

Size (approx) 121 x 150 cms/48 x 59 ins

SEAN SHEEP ROKEWOOD YARN

4 x 100g balls 1st Colour (**C1** - silver)

4 x 100g balls 2nd Colour (**C2** - print)

4 x 100g balls 3rd Colour (**C3** - china)

NEEDLES

A 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Circular Needle **or size that gives correct tension/gauge.**

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

TENSION/GAUGE

27 sts = 13.5 cms/5 ins in width, using 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

St/s - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **K2tog** - knit 2 sts together, **cont** - continue, **rep** - repeat, **rem** - remain/ing, **sl** - slip, **patt** - pattern, **psso** - pass slipped st over, **p2sso** - pass 2 slipped sts over, **beg** - begin/ning, **fol** - following, **yfwd** - yarn forward to make a stitch.

CREATE

Throw

Using 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Circular Needle and **C1**, cast on 243 sts.

Note - Work in rows, not rounds.

Next row (WS) - Knit.

Beg patt -

****** Using **C1**, **1st row** - * K1, sl 1, K1, psso, K9, sl 2, K1, p2sso, K9, K2tog, K1, rep from * to end.

2nd row - * K1, [P1, K4, (K1, yfwd, K1) all in next st, K4] twice, P1, K1, rep from * to end. Rep 1st and 2nd rows for 10 cms/4 ins, ending with a 2nd row.

Using **C2**, rep 1st and 2nd rows for 10 cms/4 ins, ending with a 2nd row.

Using **C3**, rep 1st and 2nd rows for 10 cms/4 ins, ending with a 2nd row. ******

Rep from ****** to ****** until work measures approx 150 cms/59 ins from beg, ending with a complete 10 cm/4 in stripe.

Using colour from previous row, **Next row** - Knit.

Cast/bind off very loosely knitways.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends towards centre of throw, instead of along side edges.
