Yarn required:

## SEAN SHEEP CHUNKY TEXAS

Circular Cushion $-9 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls Square Cushion $-11 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls Triangle Cushion $-7 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls

## Geo Cushions

## Intermediate Crochet)

## MEASUREMENT

Size (approx) $50 \times 50 \mathrm{cms} / 20 \times 20$ ins

## SEAN SHEEP CHUNKY TEXAS YARN

$9 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls for Circular Cushion
$11 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls for Square Cushion
$7 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls for Triangle Cushion

## HOOK

A 10 mm (US N/P 15) (UK 000) Crochet Hook.

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle; Polyester Filling.

## TENSION/GAUGE

Note - Correct tension/gauge is not essential for these cushions.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Note - Instructions are in UK/ Australian terminology.
ch - chain, beg - begin/ning, cont - continue, dc - double crochet, dec - decrease, inc - increase, patt - pattern, rep - repeat, sp - space, st - stitch, tr - treble.

## HOW TO MAKE A MAGIC RING

Step 1 - Begin by wrapping the yarn twice around your fingers.
Step 2 - Put your crochet hook through the center of the loops.
Step 3 - Pull the yarn (that comes from the ball) through the center of the loops and make 1ch.

## CREATE

Circular Cushion (back and front - both alike)
Using 10mm (US N/P 15), (UK 000) Hook, make a Magic Ring, 1ch.
Note - Do not join, but work in continuous rounds, placing a marker at beg of round and moving it at the completion of each round.
1st round - 6dc in ring.
2nd round - 2 dc in each dc to end $=12 \mathrm{dc}$.
3 rd round - * 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in next st, rep from * to end $=18 \mathrm{dc}$.
4th round - * 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of next 2 dc , rep from * to end $=24 \mathrm{dc}$

5th round - * 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of next 3 dc , rep from * to end = 24dc
Cont inc in this manner, working an extra dc between each inc until there are 90 dc .
Next round - 1dc in each of next 7dc, * 2dc in next st, 1 dc in each of next 14 dc , rep from * to last 8dc, $2 d c$ in next dc, 1dc in each of next 7dc $=96 \mathrm{dc}$
Next round - 1dc in each of next 8dc, * 2dc in next st, 1 dc in each of next 15dc, rep from * to last 8dc, 2 dc in next $\mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next $7 \mathrm{dc}=102 \mathrm{dc}$
Next round - 1dc in each dc to end, sl st in next dc. Fasten off.

Square Cushion (back and front - both alike)
Using 10 mm Hook, make 37ch.
1st row - Miss 1ch, 1dc in each ch to end $=36 \mathrm{dc}$.
2nd row - $1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each dc to end.
Rep last row until work measures approx $50 \mathrm{cms} / 20$ ins from beg. Fasten off.

Triangle Cushion (back and front - both alike)
Using 10mm (US N/P 15), (UK O00) Hook, make a Magic Ring, 1ch.
Note - Do not join, but work in continuous rounds, placing a marker at beg of round and moving it at the completion of each round.
1st round - 6dc in ring.
2nd round - 2 dc in each dc to end $=12 \mathrm{dc}$.
3rd round - 1 dc in each of next 2dc, (3dc in next $\mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 3dc) twice, 3 dc in next dc , 1 dc in next dc $=18 \mathrm{dc}$
4th round - 1 dc in each of next 3 dc , ( 3 dc in next $\mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 5 dc ) twice, 3 dc in next dc , 1 dc in each of next $2 \mathrm{dc}=24 \mathrm{dc}$.
5th round - 1 dc in each of next 4dc, (3dc in next $\mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 7dc) twice, 3dc in next dc, 1 dc in each of next $3 \mathrm{dc}=30 \mathrm{dc}$.
Cont inc in this manner, working 2 extra dc between each inc, until diameter measures approx $50 \mathrm{cms} / 20$ ins at longest point. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Join front and back pieces together, leaving an opening for filling. Fill firmly with polyester filling and close opening.
