3 x 100g balls (C1)

3 x 100g balls (C2)

3 x 100g balls (C3)

2 x 100g balls (C4)

Soft Dreamy Blanket *(Intermediate Knitting)*

MEASUREMENTS

Size (approx) 120 x 156 cms/47 ins x 61 ins

SEAN SHEEP CHENILLE TULLY YARN

3 x 100g balls 1st Colour (**C1** - almond)

3 x 100g balls 2nd Colour (**C2** - pink)

3 x 100g balls 3rd Colour (**C3** - print)

2 x 100g balls 4th Colour (**C4** - cream)

NEEDLES

A pair 9.00mm (US 13), (UK 00) Knitting Needles
or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

TENSION/GAUGE

6 sts and 15 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over patt, using 9.00mm (US 13), (UK 00) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **beg** - begin/ning, **cont** - continue, **rep** - repeat, **patt** - pattern, **sl** - slip, **tog** - together, **pssso** - pass slipped st over, **yfwd** - yarn forward to make a stitch, **incl** - inclusive.

CREATE

Using 9.00mm (US 13), (UK 00) Needles and **C1**, cast on 73 sts loosely.

Beg patt - 1st row (RS) - K1, * yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from * to end.

2nd row - Purl.

3rd row - K1, * yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to end.

4th row - Purl.

Rows 1 to 4 inclusive form patt.

Cont in patt for 13 cms/5 ins, ending with a purl row.

Break off C1.

Using **C2**, cont in patt for 13 cms/5 ins, ending with a purl row. Break off C2.

Using **C3**, cont in patt for 13 cms/5 ins, ending with a purl row. Break off C3.

Using **C4**, cont in patt for 13 cms/5 ins, ending with a purl row. Break off C4.

Last 4 stripes form stripe sequence throughout. Cont to work in patt and stripes until work measures approx 156 cms/61 ins from beg, ending with a complete stripe.

Cast/bind off loosely.

FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends towards centre of blanket, instead of along side edges.
