

# SEAN C SHEEP

10 Stitch Baby Blanket

Yarn required: SEAN SHEEP FLOWERDALE YARN 2 x 150g balls

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> > Skill Level

## 10 Stitch Baby Blanket (Intermediate Knitting)

#### MEASUREMENTS

Size (approx) 75 x 75 cm/30 x 30 ins

#### SEAN SHEEP FLOWERDALE YARN

2 x 150g balls

#### NEEDLES

A 6.00mm (US 10), (UK 4) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

#### MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

#### **TENSION/GAUGE**

13 sts and 26 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over garter st, using 6.00mm (US 10), (UK 4) Knitting Needles.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

**St/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **garter st** - every row knit, **sl** slip, **cont** - continue, **psso** - pass slipped st over.

### CREATE

#### Blanket

Using 6.00mm (US 10), (UK 4) Needles, cast on 10 sts.

**Note** - Slip first st of each row. When turning, bring yarn to front of work, slip next st onto right hand needle, yarn back, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed, this avoids holes in work.

Knit 18 rows garter st (1st row is RS) = 9 ridges.

**Work Corner** - **\*\* Next row** - Sl 1, K8, yarn front, sl 1 purlways, yarn back, **turn**.

**Next row** - SI 1 purlways, yarn back, K9.

**Next row** - Sl 1, K7, yarn front, sl 1 purlways, yarn back, **turn**.

Next row - Sl 1 purlways, yarn back, K8.

Cont working one less st (as before) in every ridge and noting to work turnings as above to avoid holes in work until there is only one st to work, knit this st rather than slipping the st.

Now work this process in reverse, working one st more up to 9 sts, noting to work the turnings. \*\*

Next row - Knit across all 10 sts, turn.

Rep from \*\* to \*\* to work another corner.

Work back along the side of the original 9 ridges, joining work as you go as in next 2 rows.

**1st row** - SI 1, K8, sI 1, knit up one st from the side of the

knitting, pass slipped st over.

2nd row - Knit across all 10 sts.

Cont to work the next corner from \*\* to \*\*, then cont on along to the next side.

Cont this process until enough yarn remains to cast off.

Cast off remaining st.

Using yarn needle, sew in ends.
