## Baby Vest & Beanie

**NEEDLES:** A pair 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

**MATERIALS:** 2 x 250g balls Sean Sheep Filo Grande yarn; 2 Stitch Holders; A Yarn Needle.

### MEASUREMENTS:

### ABBREVIATIONS:

<b>K</b>	knit
<b>P</b>	purl
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>st/s</b>	stitch/es
<b>yrn</b>	yarn

**TENSION/GAUGE:** 19 sts to 10cm over stocking stitch using 5.00mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing the garment, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles, if there are less stitches use smaller needles.

## VEST BACK

Using 4.50mm needles cast on 42(48, 54, 58) sts.

**1st Row:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st row until work measures 2cm.

Change to 5.00mm needles and cont in st st until work measures 16(17, 18, 19)cm from beg, ending on a wrong side row.

### Shape Armholes

Cast off 2(3, 4, 5) sts at beginning of next 2 rows.

38(42, 46, 48) sts.

Decrease 1 st at each end of next and following alternate rows 1(2, 3, 3) times.

34(36, 38, 40) sts.

Cont in st st until Armhole measures 5(6, 7, 8)cm ending with a wrong side row.

Work 2cm in K1, P1 rib (as for band), ending on a wrong side row.\*\*

### Shape Shoulders

Rib 9(9, 9, 9), and place these sts onto a stitch holder, cast off next 16(18, 20, 22) sts, rib 9(9, 9, 9).

\*\*\*Cont on last 9(9, 9, 9) sts, rib 12(14, 16, 18) rows.

**Buttonhole Row:** Rib 4(4, 4, 4), yrn, K2tog, rib 3(3, 3, 3).

Work 2 rows rib.

Cast off.\*\*\*

Join yarn to remaining 9(9, 9, 9) sts from stitch holder and rep from \*\*\* to \*\*\*.

## VEST FRONT

Work as for Back to \*\*.

Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP

Sew side seams, sew on buttons. Press lightly with a warm iron and a damp cloth.

## BEANIE

Using a set of 5.00mm needles, cast on 48(56, 64, 72) sts place marker to indicate beginning of round, and being careful not to twist stitches join to begin knitting in the round.

**Round 1:** \*K2, P2, rep from \* to end of round.

Rep round 1 until work measures 6cm from cast on edge.

Work in st st (knit every round) until piece measures 13.5(15, 16, 17)cm from cast on edge.

### Decrease for Crown

**Round 1:** \*Knit 6, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round.

**Round 2 and all alternate rounds:** Knit.

**Round 3:** \*Knit 5, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round.

**Round 5:** \*Knit 4, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round.

**Round 7:** \*Knit 3, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round.

**Round 9:** \*Knit 2, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round.

**Round 11:** \*Knit 1, K2tog, rep from \* to end of round.

Break off yarn leaving a tail.

Thread tail through remaining stitches and pull tight to secure.

Weave in ends.
