## Matching Beanies

**NEEDLES:** A pair 6.50mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

**MATERIALS:** 6-7 x 250g balls Sean Sheep Filo Grande yarn; 8.00 circular knitting or set of double pointed needles 10mm pair of knitting needles

### MEASUREMENTS:

### ABBREVIATIONS:

<b>K</b>	knit
<b>P</b>	purl
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>st/s</b>	stitch/es
<b>yrn</b>	yarn

**TENSION/GAUGE:** 19 sts to 10cm over stocking stitch using 5.00mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing the garment, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles, if there are less stitches use smaller needles.

## 4 PLY RIBBED BEANIE

**ACCESSORIES** - A 3.25mm set and circular needle/s or size needles to give correct tension, 4 stitch markers.

**TENSION** - 42 sts and 35 rows to 10cm over rib pattern using 3.25mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this beanie, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles. If there are less stitches use smaller needles.

**BEANIE** - Using a 3.25mm circular needle cast on **96** (120, **144**, 168, **184**) sts.

Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

**1st Round:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

Cont in rib as in 1st round until Beanie measures 17 (20, 23, 24, 26)cm from beg.

### Shape Crown

**Note:** Switch to set of needles when stitches no longer comfortably fit onto circular needle.

**Next Round:** \*rib24 (30, 36, 42, 46) sts, place marker, rep from \* 3 times, rib to end.

**1st Round:** \*(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, K2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).

**2nd Round:** \*(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, P2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, P2tog tbl, rep from \* to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).

Rep last 2 rounds **2** (3, **5**, 6, **7**) times.

Then 1st round **0** (1, **0**, 1, **1**) time/s.

**All Sizes:** 48 sts.

Work **0** (1, **0**, 1, **1**) round/s.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, (K1, P1) twice, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. 40 sts.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, P1, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. 32 sts.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. **24** sts.

Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

Sew in ends, and add a pom pom if desired.

## 8 PLY RIBBED BEANIE

**ACCESSORIES** - A 4.00mm set and circular needle/s or size needles to give correct tension, 4 stitch markers.

**TENSION** - 32 sts and 27 rows to 10cm over rib pattern using 4.00mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this beanie, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles. If there are less stitches use smaller needles.

**BEANIE** - Using a 4.00mm circular needle cast on **80** (96, **112**, 128, **144**) sts.

Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

**1st Round:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

Cont in rib as in 1st round until Beanie measures **17** (20, 23, 24, 26)cm from beg.

### Shape Crown

**Note:** Switch to set of needles when stitches no longer comfortably fit onto circular needle.

**Next Round:** \*rib20 (24, 28, 32, 36) sts, place marker, rep from \* 3 times, rib to end.

**1st Round:** \*(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, K2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).

**2nd Round:** \*(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, P2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, P2tog tbl, rep from \* to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).

Rep last 2 rounds 1 (2, 3, 4, 5) times.

**All Sizes:** 48 sts.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, (K1, P1) twice, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. 40 sts.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, P1, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. 32 sts.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. **24** sts.

Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

Sew in ends, and add a pom pom if desired.

## 10 PLY RIBBED BEANIE

**ACCESSORIES** - A 5.00mm set and circular needle/s or size needles to give correct tension, 4 stitch markers.

**TENSION** - 28 sts and 22 rows to 10cm over rib pattern using 5.00mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this beanie, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles. If there are less stitches use smaller needles.

**BEANIE** - Using a 5.00mm circular needle cast on **72** (80, **96**, 112, **128**) sts.

Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

**1st Round:** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

Cont in rib as in 1st round until Beanie measures **17** (20, **23**, 24, **26**)cm from beg.

### Shape Crown

**Note:** Switch to set of needles when stitches no longer comfortably fit onto circular needle.

**Next Round:** \*rib18 (20, **24**, 28, **32**) sts, place marker, rep from \* 3 times, rib to end.

**1st Round:** \*(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, K2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).

**2nd Round:** \*(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, P2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, P2tog tbl, rep from \* to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).

Rep last 2 rounds **0** (1, **2**, 3, **4**) times.

Then 1st round **1** (0, **0**, 0, **0**) time/s.

**All Sizes:** 48 sts.

Work **1** (0, **0**, 0, **0**) round/s.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, (K1, P1) twice, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. **40** sts.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, P1, K1, P1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. **32** sts.

**Next Round:** \*sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from \* to end. **24** sts.

Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

Sew in ends, and add a pom pom if desired.
