

NEEDLES: A pair 6.50 mm (US 10½), (UK 3) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.
MATERIALS: $6-7 \times 250 \mathrm{~g}$ balls Sean Sheep Filo Grande yarn; 8.00 circular knitting or set of double pointed needles 10 mm pair of knitting needles

## MEASUREMENTS:

TENSION/GAUGE: 19 sts to 10 cm over stocking stitch using 5.00 mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing the garment, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles, if there are less stitches use smaller needles.

## 4 PLY RIBBED BEANIE

ACCESSORIES - A 3.25 mm set and circular needle/s or size needles to give correct tension, 4 stitch markers.

TENSION - 42 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm over rib pattern using 3.25 mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this beanie, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles. If there are less stitches use smaller needles.

BEANIE - Using a 3.25 mm circular needle cast on 96 (120, 144, 168, 184) sts.
Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.
1st Round: *K1, P1, rep from * to end.
Cont in rib as in 1st round until Beanie measures 17 (20, $23,24,26) \mathrm{cm}$ from beg.

## Shape Crown

Note: Switch to set of needles when stitches no longer comfortably fit onto circular needle.
Next Round: *rib24 (30, 36, 42, 46) sts, place marker, rep from * 3 times, rib to end.
1st Round: *(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, K2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, sl 1, K1, psso, rep from * to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).
2nd Round: *(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, P2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, P2tog tbl, rep from * to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).
Rep last 2 rounds $2(3,5,6,7)$ times.
Then 1 st round $0(1,0,1,1)$ time/s.
All Sizes: 48 sts.
Work $0(1,0,1,1)$ round/s.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, (K1, P1) twice, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 40 sts.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, K1, P1, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 32 sts.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 24 sts.
Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.
Sew in ends, and add a pom pom if desired.

## 8 PLY RIBBED BEANIE

ACCESSORIES - A 4.00 mm set and circular needle/s or size needles to give correct tension, 4 stitch markers.

TENSION - 32 sts and 27 rows to 10 cm over rib pattern using 4.00 mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this beanie, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles. If there are less stitches use smaller needles.

BEANIE - Using a 4.00 mm circular needle cast on 80 (96, $112,128,144)$ sts.
Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.
1st Round: *K1, P1, rep from * to end.
Cont in rib as in 1st round until Beanie measures 17 (20, $23,24,26) \mathrm{cm}$ from beg.

## Shape Crown

Note: Switch to set of needles when stitches no longer comfortably fit onto circular needle.

Next Round: *rib20 $(24,28,32,36)$ sts, place marker, rep from * 3 times, rib to end.
1st Round: *(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, K2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, sl 1, K1, psso, rep from * to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).
2nd Round: *(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, P2tog, rib to 2 sts
before next marker, P2tog tbl, rep from * to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).
Rep last 2 rounds $1(2,3,4,5)$ times.
All Sizes: 48 sts.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, (K1, P1) twice, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 40 sts.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, K1, P1, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 32 sts.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 24 sts.
Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.
Sew in ends, and add a pom pom if desired.

## 10 PLY RIBBED BEANIE

ACCESSORIES - A 5.00 mm set and circular needle/s or size needles to give correct tension, 4 stitch markers.
TENSION - 28 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm over rib pattern using 5.00 mm needles. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this beanie, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches use larger needles. If there are less stitches use smaller needles.

BEANIE - Using a 5.00 mm circular needle cast on 72 (80, $96,112,128)$ sts.
Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.
1st Round: *K1, P1, rep from * to end.
Cont in rib as in 1st round until Beanie measures 17 (20,
$23,24,26) \mathrm{cm}$ from beg.

## Shape Crown

Note: Switch to set of needles when stitches no longer comfortably fit onto circular needle.
Next Round: *rib18 (20, 24, 28, 32) sts, place marker, rep from * 3 times, rib to end.
1 st Round: *(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, K2tog, rib to 2 sts before next marker, sl 1, K1, psso, rep from * to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).
2nd Round: *(K1, P1) 4 times, K1, P2tog, rib to 2 sts
before next marker, P2tog tbl, rep from * to end of round, (8 stitches decreased).
Rep last 2 rounds $0(1,2,3,4)$ times.
Then 1 st round $1(0,0,0,0)$ time/s.
All Sizes: 48 sts.
Work 1 ( $0,0,0,0$ ) round/s.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, (K1, P1) twice, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 40 sts.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, P1, K1, P1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 32 sts.
Next Round: *sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1, rep from * to end. 24 sts.
Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.
Sew in ends, and add a pom pom if desired.
