

Corner to Corner Blanket Easy Knitting

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MEASUREMENTS	
Width (approx)	70cm
Length (approx)	70cm
SEAN SHEEP 8 PLY ACRYLIC PRINTS 100g balls	
Quantity (429305 Rhapsody)	2
Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantity is approximate as it can vary between knitters. Ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.	

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

• 4mm (UK 8) circular knitting needle (80-100cm long).

• wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION

21 sts and 29 rows to 10cm over stocking st (knit 1 row, purl 1 row), using 4mm needles.

Correct tension is not essential for this blanket, however stated measurements and yarn quantity are based on this tension.

BLANKET

Using 4mm **circular** needle, cast on 2 sts. **NOTE** – Circular needle is used to accommodate increasing number of sts. Work backwards and forwards in rows.

1st row – Inc knitways in each st ... 4 sts.

2nd row – Inc purlways in first st, P2, inc purlways in last st ... 6 sts.

3rd row – Inc knitways in first st, K4, inc knitways in last st ... 8 sts.

4th row – Purl.

 $5th\ row$ – Inc knitways in first st, knit to last st, inc knitways in last st ... 10 sts.

6th row – Inc purlways in first st, purl to last st, inc purlways in last st \dots 12 sts.

7th row – As 5th row ... 14 sts.

8th row – Purl.

9th row – As 5th row ... 16 sts.

10th row – Purl.

 $\ensuremath{\textbf{11th row}}\xspace - \ensuremath{\text{As 5th row}}\xspace \ldots$ 18 sts.

12th row – As 6th row ... 20 sts.

13th row – As 5th row ... 22 sts.

14th row – Purl.

Rep last 10 rows 12 times ... 190 sts. Rep 5th and 6th rows once ... 194 sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

NEED PATTERN HELP?

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BEG DEC -

1st row – K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog ... 192 sts.
2nd row – P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, P2tog ... 190 sts.
3rd row – As 1st row ... 188 sts.
4th row – Purl.
Rep last 4 rows once ... 182 sts.
9th row – As 1st row ... 180 sts.
10th row – Purl.
Rep last 10 rows 12 times ... 12 sts.
Next row – K2tog, K8, K2tog ... 10 sts.
Next row – P2tog, P6, P2tog ... 8 sts.
Next row – Purl.
Next row – Purl.
Next row – K2tog, K4, K2tog ... 6 sts.
Next row – Purl.
Next row – Purl.
Next row – Purl.
Next row – K2tog, K2, K2tog ... 4 sts.
Next row – K2tog, tasten off.

FIRST 2 BORDERS -

With right side facing and using 4mm **circular** needle, knit up 114 sts evenly along one edge. Work 12 rows garter st (every row knit). Cast off loosely knitways (on wrong side). Rep on opposite side edge.

NEXT 2 BORDERS -

With right side facing and using 4mm **circular** needle, knit up 126 sts evenly along one of rem edges, including side edges of first 2 borders. Work 12 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely knitways (on wrong side). Rep on rem side edge.

TO MAKE UP

Sew in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

approx = approximately
beg = begin
dec = decrease, decreasing
garter st = knit every row
inc = increase
K = knit
P = purl

rem = remain, remaining
rep = repeat
st, sts = stitch, stitches
stocking st = knit right side
rows, purl wrong side rows
tog = together
