HOPSCOTCH BLANKET

Intermediate Knitting

MEASUREMENTS	
Width (approx)	60cm
Length (approx)	80cm
SEAN SHEEP LITTLE POPPET 100g balls	
Colourway 1	
1st Colour (C1 – 433470 White)	2
2nd Colour (C2 – 433472 Lilac)	2
Colourway 2	
1st Colour (C1 – 433474 Aqua)	2
2nd Colour (C2 – 433473 Soft Blue)	2
Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Ensure all yarn of the same colour is from the same dye lot.	

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 6.5mm (UK 3) **circular** knitting needle (80cm long).
- wool needle for finishing.

TENSION

13 sts and 18 rows to 10cm over stocking st (knit 1 row, purl 1 row), using 6.5mm needles.

Correct tension is not essential for this blanket, however stated measurements and yarn quantities are based on this tension.

NOTE – This blanket is worked on larger needles than usually recommended for this yarn.

BLANKET

NOTE – A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work backwards and forwards in rows.

Using 6.5mm **circular** needle and **C1**, cast on 26 sts, using **C2** cast on 26 sts, then using another ball of **C1**, cast on 26 sts ... 78 sts.

NOTE – When changing colours for intarsia method within a row, twist new colour under and to the right of finished colour on wrong side, making sure yarns are worked firmly at joins.

BEG FIRST SECTION –

1st row (right side) – Using **C1** K26, using **C2** K26, using **C1** K26.

2nd row – Using **C1** P26, using **C2** P26, using **C1** P26.

NOTE – Mark right side of work with a safety pin or coloured thread.

Rep last 2 rows until section measures 20cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Next row – Using **C1** K26, do not break off yarn, using **C2** K26, do not break off yarn, using **C1** K26, break off yarn.

BEG SECOND SECTION –

With right side facing, join another ball of **C2** and proceed as follows –
1st row – Using **C2** K26, using **C1** (attached) K26, using **C2** (attached) K26.

2nd row – Using **C2** P26, using **C1** P26, using **C2** P26.

Rep last 2 rows until section measures 20cm from beg, ending with a 2nd row.

Next row – Using **C2** K26, do not break off yarn, using **C1** K26, do not break off yarn, using **C2** K26, break off yarn.

With right side facing, rejoin ball of **C1** and rep first section using yarns still attached.

With right side facing, rejoin ball of **C2** and rep second section.

Cast off loosely in patt.

stocking st = knit right side
