Quantity (436575 Rise)		2	3	3	4	4
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Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair each 3.25mm (UK 10) and 4mm (UK 8) knitting needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- wool needle for sewing seams.
- 1 button.

TENSION

21 stitches and 44 rows to 10cm over garter stitch (every row knit), using 4mm needles.

To work a tension square, using 4mm needles, cast on 32 stitches. Work 66 rows garter stitch.

Cast off loosely.

Check your tension carefully.

If fewer stitches to 10cm use smaller needles, if more stitches use larger needles.

CARDIGAN

BACK

Using 4mm needles, cast on **46** (52-**58**-60-**62**) stitches.

NOTE – Mark right side of work with a safety pin or tie a coloured thread on 2nd row.

Work in garter stitch (every row knit, first row is wrong side) until Back measures **22** (25-**28**-31-**33**) cm from beginning, working last row on wrong side.

Cast off loosely.

FRONTS (make 2 alike)

Using 4mm needles, cast on **23** (26-**29**-30-**31**) stitches. Work in garter stitch (first row is wrong side) until Front measures same as Back, working last row on wrong side. Cast off loosely.

SLEEVES

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on **35** (39-**44**-46-**48**) stitches. Work 11 rows garter stitch (first row is wrong side).

Change to 4mm needles.

Continue until Sleeve measures **13** (16-**19**-21-**23**) cm from beginning, working last row on wrong side.

Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

Using Mattress stitch, join Back and Fronts together for **5** (6-7-8-8) cm at cast-off edges for shoulders, leaving centre open for back neck. Fold 6cm of top corners of each Front down and slip stitch in position. Measure down **9** (10-**11**-11.5-**12**) cm from each shoulder seam on Back and Fronts and tie a coloured thread at side edges to mark armholes. Placing centre of sleeve top to shoulder seam, sew in Sleeves evenly between coloured threads. Join side and sleeve seams. Work a stitched-chain button loop on Right Front below folded corner. Sew button on Left Front to correspond. Sew in ends.
